**Integrated Transport and Infrastructure**



Develop and deliver an integrated regional approach to transport infrastructure and public transport services

The integration of transport and land-use planning is essential to achieve the new urban form. We must work to create a transit-focused region that facilitates the efficient movement of people, goods and services. Access to affordable and accessible public transport is also a critical issue for many people, particularly the elderly as it can assist to remain independent, sustain social networks and gain access to health care.

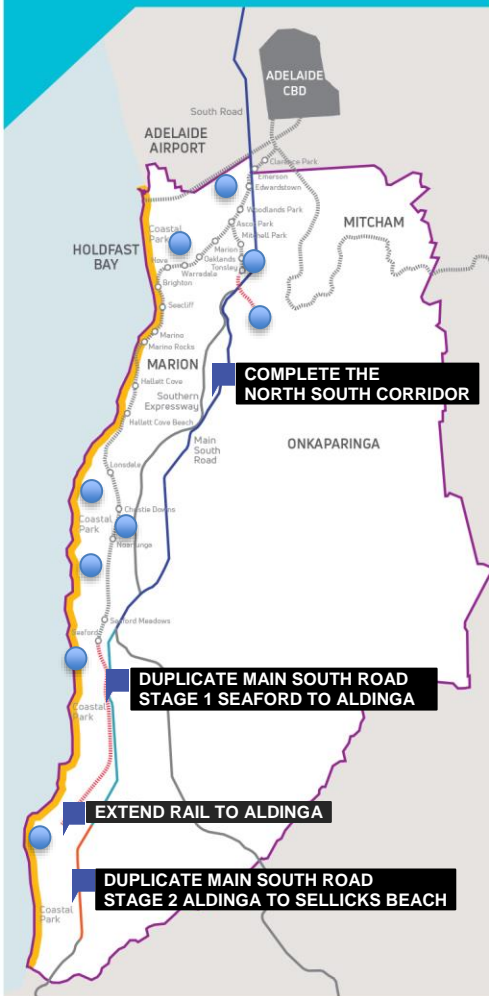
New investment in road and rail, a redesigned bus network and more cycling and walking networks will provide the physical infrastructure needed to increase travel options and help service growth precincts (shown with a dot).

The enhancement of our transport infrastructure will deliver more efficient supply chains for our export industries and freight networks, whilst providing people with the right transport choices, no matter where they need to travel.

Key projects to be delivered for Southern Adelaide are:

1. Completion of the North South Corridor
2. Extension of the rail line from Seaford to Aldinga
3. Integration of modes of travel at growth precincts
4. Duplication of Main South Road

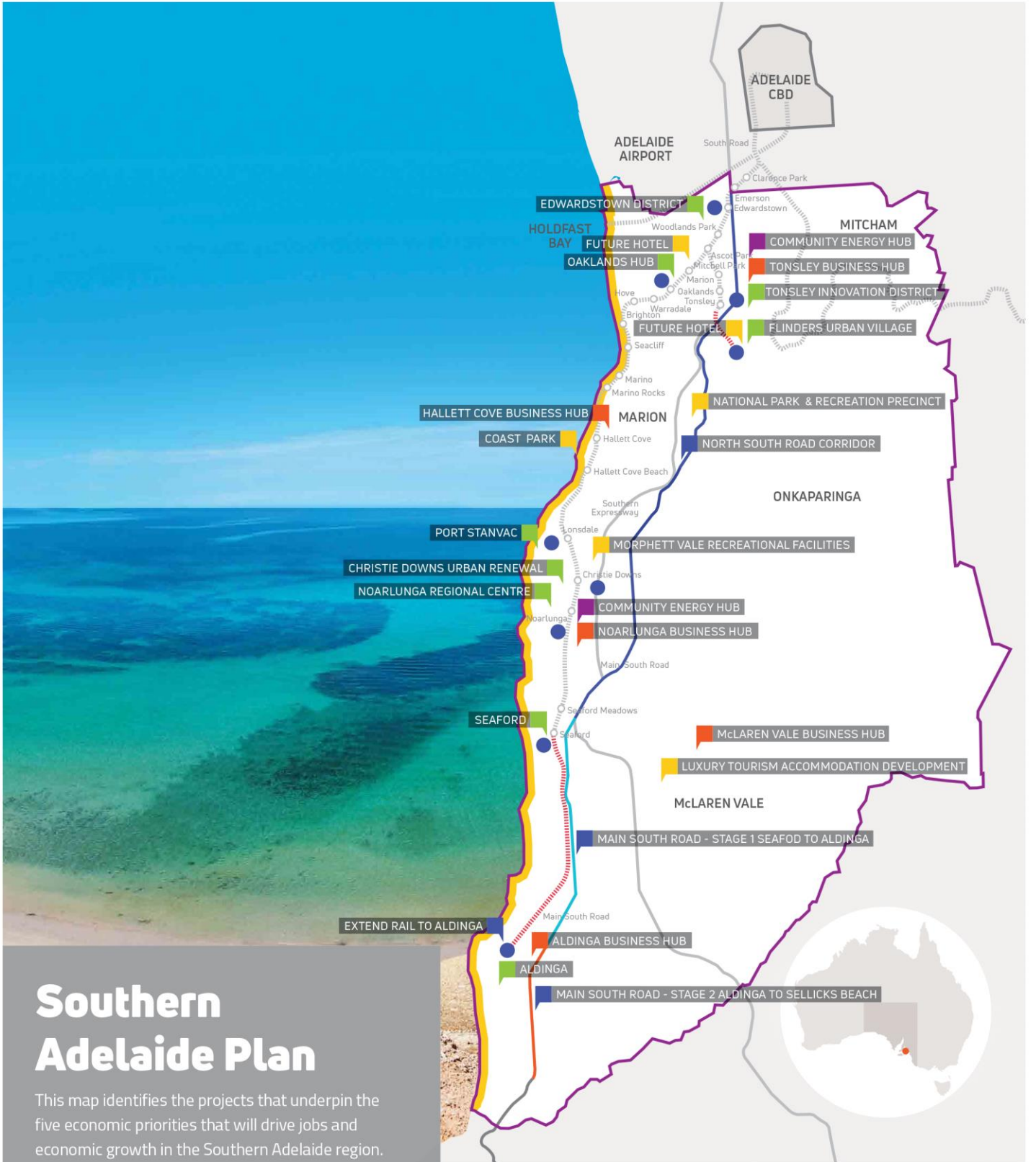
