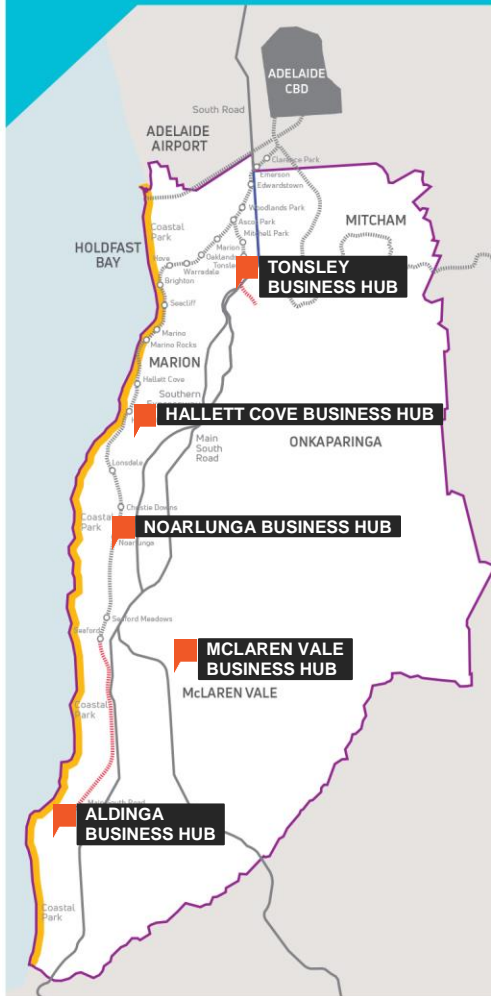


PRIORITY 4

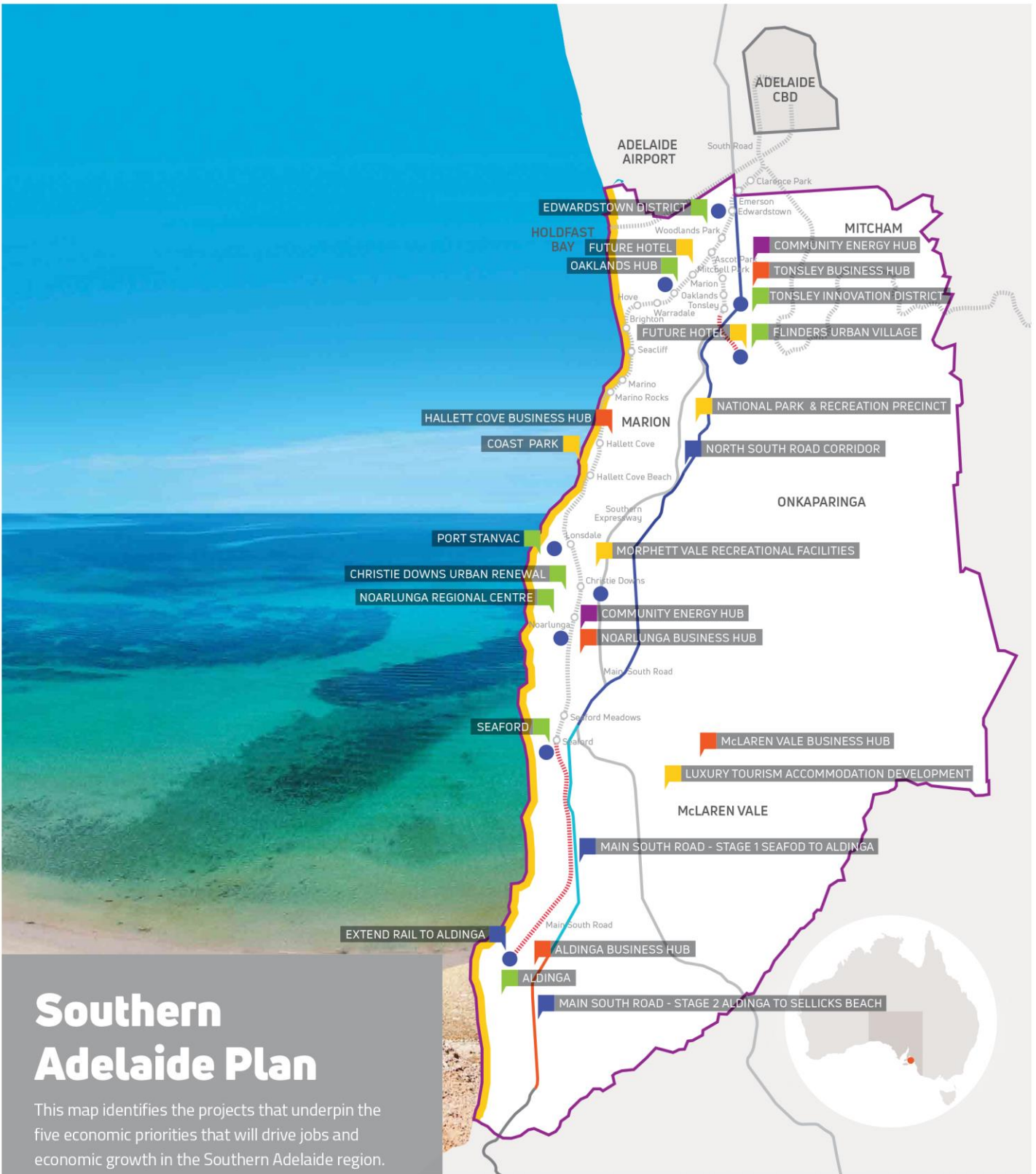
